Sam has £16 left.

2 One half of a number is 6 What is double the number?

$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

 $12 \times 2 = 24$

24 is double the number.





Mo gives Alex some stickers.

They now have the same number of stickers.

How many stickers does Mo give Alex?

$$60 - 42 = 18$$

 $18 \div 2 = 9$

Mo gives Alex 9 stickers.
