

What is an adaptation?

Success Criteria:

- Describe different environments.
- Match animals to the best suited environment.
- Know the definition of 'adaptations' and can give examples.
- Know how animals and plants adapt to different environments.

In this lesson, we will be learning about adaptations. We will be looking at the conditions in different environments and the characteristics that animals have that help them to survive. We are then going to design our own creatures that are adapted to an environment! You will need a pen, pencil, coloured pencil (or something to mark with), a ruler and a piece of paper for this lesson.
